Eligibility is based on a household's income, housing costs, and medical expenses. The average SNAP benefit for older adults is \$106 per month.

Housing and out of pocket medical expenses help seniors maximize the monthly benefit amount. Call our helpline to find out if you might be eligible.

SNAP benefits are quick and easy to apply for!

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) helps seniors purchase food. Benefits are provided monthly on an EBT card.

Now enrollment is easier than ever through the Elderly Simplified Application Process (ESAP). This process simplifies the SNAP application and recertification process for older Pennsylvanians and individuals with a disability who have no earned income.

- Simplified two-page application
- 36-month certification
- Few or no verifications required



Start saving on your groceries today!

At the Central Pennsylvania Food Bank, our team of experts will provide assistance through our bilingual **Food Stamps Helpline**. Our SNAP associates will:

- 1. Pre-screen you for potential eligibility
- 2. Provide an estimated SNAP benefit amount
- 3. Submit your SNAP application and advise you on what to expect next
- 4. Check in with you to provide additional support
- 5. Assist with renewing your benefits

Our SNAP associates may be able to help you **save \$180 or more a year** on groceries.

Senior SNAP participants are less likely to enter a nursing home and less likely to be hospitalized in the year after receiving SNAP than non-participants. SNAP participation have also been linked to lower overall health care expenditures and Medicaid/Medicare costs.
